Treasurer Smith gave an update on the treasurer's report, with a balance of \$2,939.54 as of Oct. 11 . Mike Stottlemeyer moved to accept, second by Denise Nouck, and unanimously approved.

President's Report.

Landscaping Hwy 80 from Hickey Creek to Hendry County—draft went before Road Landscape Advisory Committee (RLAC). They gave recommendations for types of plants and creating hammocks. The full Alva Inc. Highway Advisory Committee met Sept. 9 and went over the suggestions.

Alva Museum/Library went before Board of County Commissioners. Zoning changed to community facility to allow garden club to make improves on the facility to better serve the community.

We had a debate on Amendment 4 regarding Hometown Democracy. Wayne Daltry argued “for” passing the amendment, and Wayne Krise argued against passing it. The members of the community then asked questions of the two debaters.

Alva Community Planner Jerry Murphy did a slide presentation on New Horizon 2035 that is re-evaluated every 7 years. He gave the website leegov.com/dcd/ear2011 for anyone who wants to read the complete report. Questions and comments followed the presentation.

President Daniels pointed out announcements of upcoming important community events on the agenda.
