President Daniels called the meeting to order at 7:06 p.m., the group said the Pledge of Allegiance together, and President Daniels gave a warm welcome to all in attendance.

Secretary Dennis read the minutes from the April 11, 2011, meeting. Mike Stottlemeyer moved to accept the minutes, Bill Redfern seconded, and they were unanimously approved.

Treasurer Smith was not able to attend, and we did not have a treasurer's report.

Community Planner Jerry Murphy gave an overview of the entire process of community planning. Then he reviewed the Alva Community Plan that was approved at our Saturday, March 30 workshop and the Northeast Lee County Vision Statement that had been endorsed at the same meeting; he then gave a brief summary of the North Olga Community Plan. He said that all three plans will be ready this Friday and Ruby will send them to us. The next step is getting reading for the land development standards process. He told us that a new 338 page document for growth management has been adopted by the state and should be on a government website.

Frank Mann then told the group that the density language in the Alva Plan is stronger, and the Olga Plan calls for status quo in density. Mr. Mann then spent a lot of time answering questions from the attendees.

Carl Veaux invited everyone to attend a reception for Ellie Boyd, a lady who spent many years in Lee County defending the environment and co-founder with her husband of the Lee County civic association Responsible Growth Management.

Denise Houck invited everyone to attend the third Relay for Life being held at Riverdale High—the theme is “Heroes.”

Stan Whitcomb gave an update on Caloosa 80, stating that several changes had been made to the original plan, including a 10 to 20 thousand foot clubhouse and two recreation areas that could be open for use by the Alva community.

President Daniels announced six upcoming community events, and the meeting ended at 8:24 p.m.
