**Minutes
Alva, Inc
February 13, 2012**

Treasurer Smith gave a report showing a current balance of \$751.23. Mike Stottlemeyer moved to accept the treasurer's report, seconded by Joyce Pelewski, and it was unanimously approved.

Alva Community Planner Jerry Murphy gave a power point presentation of an depth review of the land development codes for the Alva Rural Village that was submitted to the county planners. We are waiting to get feedback from them to see if there are any additions or changes they believe we should have. He answered questions from attendees and emphasized that we still want feedback from the community because it is OUR plan.

A possible community issue was presented by David Bull. He requested that Alva resident Nick Cutaniha, a Medal of Honor winner in the Vietnamese War, be honored by the community by renaming the Alva Community Center after him. President Daniels said that we would look further into the idea, with the possibility of doing something to also honor all the veterans from our community who served in a war.

Denise Houck announced that the Relay for Life will be held on April 27 and 28 at Riverdale High School. People who want to sign up or give contributions can find the information online.

President Daniels announced important community meetings, and we adjourned at 9: p.m.
