2. LPA Hearing on North River Village: The LPA recommended against the development! BOCC meeting is the next step.
3. Babcock Ranch Comprehensive Plan Amendment: Proposes a phenomenal amount of new/improved roads in Alva, Bayshore, and other parts of Lee County. ELCC is taking the lead in addressing this issue. First meeting: March 17th, Olga Community Center, 6:30 PM.
4. The Alva Community Plan has been adopted by the BOCC! Next steps are to add detail to the plan and adoption of the Standards of Development within the Alva Community Planning Area.

Vice President's Report:

B.J. Gerald and Denise Houck discussed the Relay for Life scheduled for May 15/16 at the Riverdale High School. Come and join the team!

Other Items:

1. Discussion followed that Mr. Pete Quasius' testimony before the LPA that Audubon supports the North River Village project may have been a misrepresentation.
